Public Transport to Bellfield Park

There are public transport options available to Bellfield Park. Please check local schedules before travelling.

Drop off and parking at Bellfield Park

There is limited parking available at Bellfield Park. Please arrange to be dropped off at Bellfield Park or use the Kiltwalk bus service to get you to the start line.

The Mighty Stride Kiltwalk bus departs from Duthie Park, Great Southern Road (AB11 7BH) to Bellfield Park in Banchory (AB31 5HT) with a stop at Robert Gordon University (AB10 7AR).

Unfortunately dogs are not allowed on board, with the exception of service dogs. We apologise for any inconvenience.

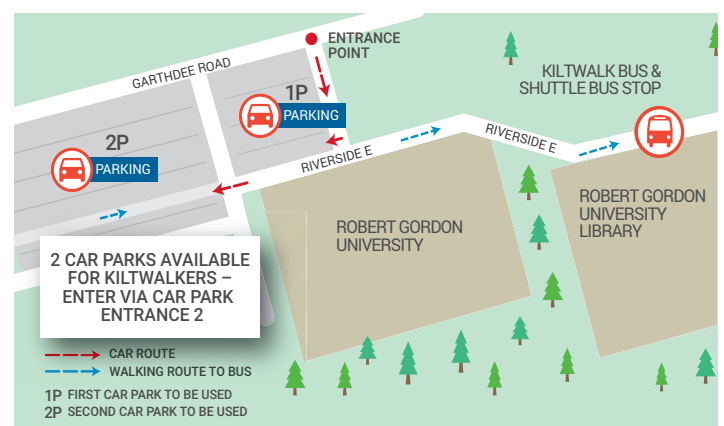
Parking at Duthie Park (For Morning Busses)

Parking and Free Shuttle Bus

Due to limited parking, we encourage all walkers to use the Kiltwalk bus service or arrange drop-off/pick-up where possible.

There is no parking available at Duthie Park, if you have parked at Robert Gordon University in the morning, you can use our free shuttle bus from Duthie Park back to your car.

Road Safety

Public Transport to Cults Academy

There are public transport options available to Cults Academy. Please check local timetables for latest schedules.

Parking and drop off at Cults Academy

There is no parking available at Cults Academy. However, we recommend parking at Robert Gordon University (AB10 7AR) and utilising our free shuttle bus to the Wee Wander Start operating from 9:00am - 11.30am. Once you have finished the walk, you can get the free shuttle bus from Duthie Park (Great Southern Road, AB11 7BH) back to your car at Robert Gordon University (AB10 7AR).

Afternoon Shuttle Bus for Wee Wanderers

There will be a free shuttle bus service throughout the day to take you from our end site at Duthie Park back to our Kiltwalk parking at Robert Gordon University.

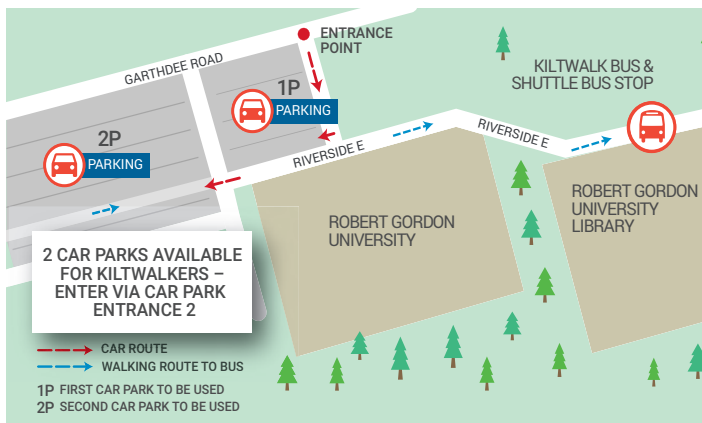
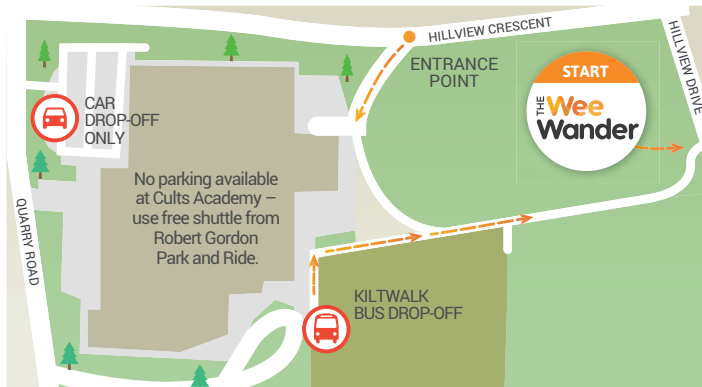
This does not need pre-booking and will leave from Great Southern Road (AB11 7BH).
