Getting to the event

MightyStriders

Public Transport to West Sands, St Andrews

Some bus services are available on Sunday morning from Dundee City Centre to St Andrews. Check online for the latest schedules.

Drop off & Parking at West Sands, St Andrews

Parking is available at West Sands, St Andrews. The drop off zone will be clearly signposted as you arrive and can be seen in the map to the right.

Morning Kiltwalk Buses for Mighty Striders

Kiltwalk bus service costs £7.50pp - check availability and [book here](#).

The Mighty Stride bus departs from our Park & Ride location at Gardyne Campus, Dundee & Angus College DD5 1NY where there is plenty of parking available and a second pick up from Slessor Gardens, South Crichton Street DD1 3AZ which is a short walk from Dundee Train Station.

This journey takes around 30 minutes to the Mighty Stride start site.

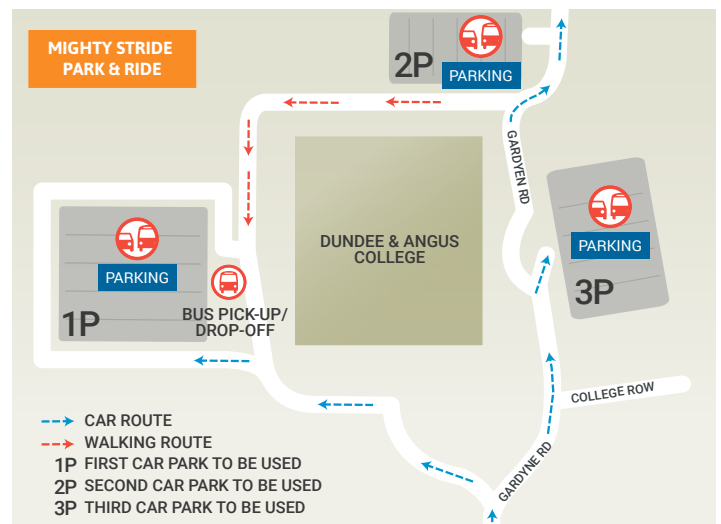
Once you've completed your walk, those who parked at Gardyne Campus, Dundee & Angus College, can utilise the Kiltwalk Free Park & Ride Shuttle Service to get back to the college and pick up their car. The Shuttle Service will operate between 12:00 and 20:00.

MightyStriders

Public Transport to St Andrews

The Kiltwalk finish line is located in Slessor Gardens within Dundee City Centre so there are many public transport options available with Dundee Train Station a 5 minute walk away and Dundee Bus Station an 8 minute walk away.

Afternoon/Evening Kiltwalk Buses for Mighty Striders

Kiltwalk bus service costs £7.50pp - check availability and [book here](#).

The evening service picks up from the Kiltwalk Village, Slessor Gardens, South Crichton Street (DD1 3AZ) and goes direct to the Mighty Stride start location at West Sands, St Andrews (KY16 9XL).

If you require accessible transport on event day, please email contactus@thekiltwalk.co.uk before booking the Kiltwalk bus.

Kiltwalk Free Park & Ride Shuttle Bus

The Park & Ride Shuttle Service is free to use and will return walkers back to their cars after completing the walk. This will be a continuous service operating between Slessor Gardens and Gardyne Campus, Dundee & Angus College (DD5 1NY). Shuttle Service Times will operate between 12:00 and 20:00.



Slessor Gardens Parking & Pick Up

There is no immediate car parking surrounding the Kiltwalk Village at Slessor Gardens, however, there are many payable car parks a short walk from the Kiltwalk Village end site.

We also have a Park & Ride facility available, see the previous section for more information.

Kiltwalkers can't get picked up from Slessor Gardens due to it's location and road closures. Please arrange pick up further away from this location.

Road Safety

Remember that the Kiltwalk does not have any right of way on roads. Please ensure that you use the Green Cross Code and stick to pavements on the official route. DO NOT walk on roads and ensure you cross at appropriate crossing points, following Kiltwalk signage at all times.

Public Transport to Broughty Ferry

Some public transport is available on a Sunday from Dundee City Centre to Broughty Ferry. Check online for the latest schedules.

Parking and Free Shuttle Service

There is no parking available at the Wee Wander start line at Castle Green. We would encourage you to use the Free Wee Wander Shuttle Service.

Kiltwalkers can park their cars at Gardyne Campus, Dundee & Angus College (DD5 1NY) where there is plenty of parking available and use the free Wee Wander Shuttle Service taking them to the start of the Wee Wander at Castle Green.

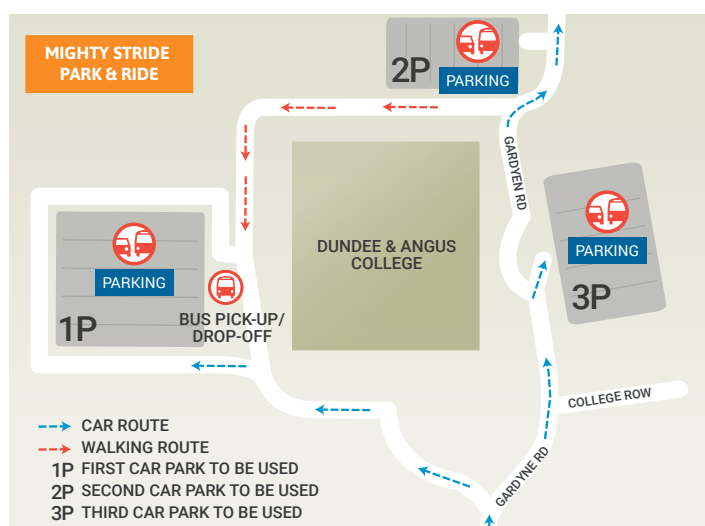
The free shuttle service will operate between 10:00 and 11:45.
