Getting to the event

MightyStriders

Public Transport to Holyrood Park

Some public transport is available on Sunday morning from the city centre to Holyrood Park. Check the Lothian Buses website for up to date information and schedules – <https://www.lothianbuses.com/>

There are limited train services on a Sunday morning. Please check www.travelinescotland.com before travelling.

No Parking at Holyrood Park

There is no parking available at Holyrood Park. Please arrange to be dropped off or use the Kiltwalk bus to get to your start line.

Morning Kiltwalk Buses for Mighty Striders

Kiltwalk bus service costs £7.50pp and is available to [book here](#).

The Mighty Stride Kiltwalk bus departs from Scottish Gas Murrayfield stadium (EH12 5PJ) where there is some parking available. The journey takes around 20 minutes to the start site.

As there is no parking available in and around Holyrood Park, there is no Afternoon/Evening Kiltwalk Bus available to book.

Westfield Road Closure & Diversions

Due to ongoing railway works, Westfield Road, near Murrayfield Stadium, will be fully closed over Edinburgh Kiltwalk weekend. If you're travelling to or from Murrayfield Stadium, where Kiltwalk parking is available, please follow the signed diversion routes and allow extra time for your journey.

Public Transport to Fisherrow Links, Musselburgh

Some public transport is available from Edinburgh City Centre to Musselburgh. Check online for the latest bus and train schedules.

Parking at Fisherrow Links, Musselburgh

No parking is available for walkers around this start site. Free parking will be available in Musselburgh Racecourse Car Parks 1 & 2 (Balcarres Road, EH21 7SB) which is a short 15 minute walk from the Big Stroll start line. The bookable Kiltwalk bus will take walkers back to the racecourse parking after the walk is completed.

The Wee Wander start site is at Victoria Park (EH6 4PZ). Please approach the start race arch just off Newhaven Road avoiding our Pit Stop set up which is just off Craighall Road.

Free Shuttle bus to Victoria Park

Parking in and around Victoria Park is extremely limited so Kiltwalk has arranged a free-to-use shuttle service that will operate between Edinburgh College, Granton Campus and Victoria Park where the Wee Wander starts. Running from 08.45am to 10.30am.

This allows Wee Wander participants to park free of charge at Edinburgh College, Granton Campus, 350 West Granton Road, Edinburgh EH5 1QE and use the free shuttle service to get to the Wee Wander start line at Victoria Park, 141 Newhaven Road, Edinburgh EH6 4PZ.

Kiltwalk bus service costs £7.50pp and is available to [book here](#).

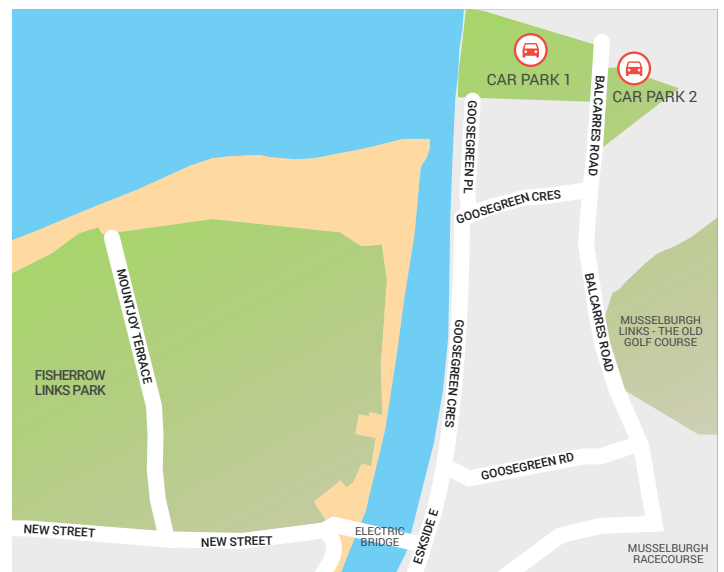
The evening service picks up from the Kiltwalk Village

at Scottish Gas Murrayfield Stadium (EH12 5PJ) and drops back at Musselburgh Racecourse in Car Park 1 or Car Park 2 (Balcarres Road, Musselburgh EH21 7SG).

Free shuttle bus to Edinburgh College

A free-to-use shuttle service will operate between Murrayfield Stadium (EH12 5QY) and Edinburgh College Granton Campus (EH5 1QE) to return Wee Wander participants to their cars.

This is a free continuous service running from 10:45am – 2:45pm with plenty of availability so no need to book.
