BigStrollers

Public Transport to Queens Quay, Alisa Road, Clydebank

First Bus and Scotrail operate services from the Greater Glasgow area to Clydebank.

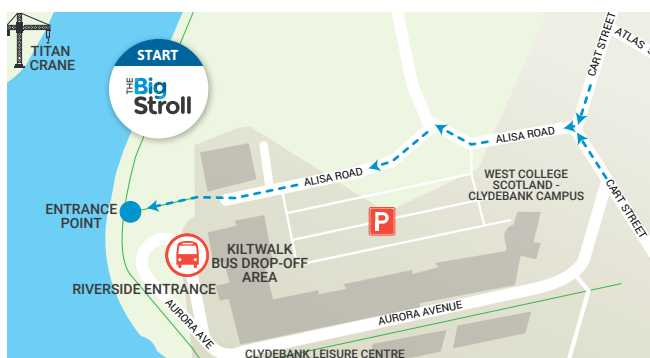
Normal Saturday public transport services into Clydebank should be in operation.

Parking near Alisa Road

Parking is available at West College Scotland, Alisa Road. In addition an overflow parking area is located next to Singers Tyres, Clydebank Retail Park, G81 2XA.

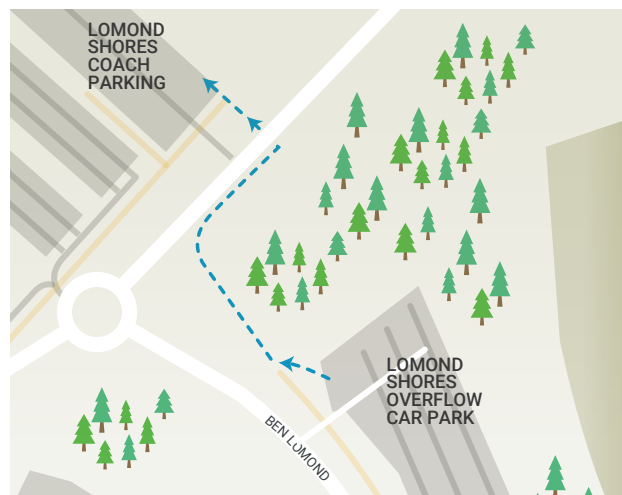
There will be a free shuttle service operating between Singers Tyres and the Big Stroll Start line at Queens Quay running from 8.45am and 12pm.



Morning Kiltwalk Buses for Big Strollers

Kiltwalk bus service costs £7.50pp and is available to [book here](#).

The bus stop for the Big Stroll morning Kiltwalk buses will depart from Loch Lomond Shores Coach Parking (Balloch G83 8QL). Paid parking is available



at Lomond Shores car park (G83 8SX) which is a 2 minute walk from Lomond Shores Coach Parking. See map with details on how to walk from Parking to the bus pick up point.

Please note, Loch Lomond shores have recently changed their parking policy and in some areas, parking charges of up to £4 may apply. For more info visit the [Loch Lomond Shores Parking Page](#).

Scotrail Trains to Clydebank

Balloch Rail Station is a short walk from the Kiltwalk Village end site in Balloch. Trains will be running 2 per hour with additional carriages put on throughout the day.

Afternoon/Evening Kiltwalk Buses for Big Strollers

Kiltwalk bus service costs £7.50pp and are available to [book here](#).

The bus stop for the Kiltwalk afternoon buses will depart from Balloch Bus Stance (G83 8JZ) which is a 2 minute walk from the Kiltwalk Village.

The bus will be stopping at the following locations:

- Bus Stop, Aurora Avenue West of Scotland College, Clydebank, G81 1BF.
- Singers Tyres, Clydebank Retail Park, 79 Livingstone Street, Clydebank G81 2XA.

Kiltwalk Shuttle Bus

We have a free shuttle bus service, taking you from the Balloch bus stance (beside the Kiltwalk Village End Site), back to Loch Lomond Shores coach parking running every 15 minutes between 12.30pm and 7.30pm.

Parking and Pick-Up Points

There is NO parking available in the Balloch area therefore we would encourage all walkers to use public transport or Kiltwalk Buses to arrive and depart from the event.

To book a Kiltwalk bus please visit [here](#). There will be no waiting/stopping/parking for cars close to the Kiltwalk Village.

Anyone looking to park for walker pick ups would be encouraged to use the Lomond Shores overflow car park (G83 8SX) and utilise the free shuttle as detailed in the previous section. Please note that parking charges of up to £4 may apply.

Road Safety

Remember that the Kiltwalk does not have any right of way on roads. Please ensure that you use the Green Cross Code and stick to pavements on the official route. DO NOT walk on roads and ensure you cross at appropriate crossing points, following Kiltwalk signage at all times.
